Presentation:

Our Presenter, Father Matthew, was introduced by our Worthy Lecturer, Greg Perkowski. Father gave a presentation on his life as a missionary and priest. Father grew up in Milan, Michigan. His father is a drag racer and longtime member of the Milan Dragway. He attended the St Joseph parish in nearby Whittaker. Father received a bachelor's degree in communications from MSU and was involved in several ministries and bible study on campus. He worked for a short time at a Christen radio station and then ended up working and living at the Straight-line Ministry homeless shelter helping to add an evangelical aspect to the ministry. After 2 and a half years at the ministry, Father felt his was being called to the Seminary and went to attend the Sacred Heart Seminary. From there his spiritual director, who is now Bishop Beau, helped him decide to join the Redemptorists. He finished his theological studies at Aquinas Institute of Theology in St Louis, Missouri. After that he was asked to go to Nigeria for three years for some mission experience. While there, Father became a formator and taught religion and English outside the city in the jungle area. After his mission experience he was ordained as deacon and then as a priest and became an associate pastor at St Alphonsus Church in St Louis. He was put on a parish preaching team and traveled all over the country preaching parish missions and retreats, Novenas, etc. He then became pastor at St Alphonsus. After several he was sent to Rome and worked in office at the Vatican and then was assigned to Baton Rouge, Louisiana where he was involved in several ministries. He was then asked to go to Minneapolis, Minnesota and became a member of the evangelization team. From there he asked to come back to the Diocese of Lansing to do ministries and experience average life as a priest. After giving this history of his life, Father took questions and gave several answers and related several of his detailed experiences while in Africa and on mission experiences in the US.

He reminded us of the State raffle drawing which will be April 21st and that the Michigan Knights of Columbus Respect Life dinner will be on April 5th.
