- K of C Kitchen Fridge Replacement – donations requested by PGK Weber and stated that in order to bring the process up to proper standards, support is needed in obtaining a commercial refrigerator to provide additional refrigeration space specifically for the Council needs; currently the Council shares a fridge with the STA Athletics; at present the Council has a little more than half of the funds necessary in obtaining a refrigeration unit that matches those in the existing kitchen, but also includes removable trays/racks for proper fish fry thawing; the remaining balance, which is to be raised through direct Council donations is \$2,400.00.
- The Council has donated \$250.00 to the Mother Teresa House generator fund.
